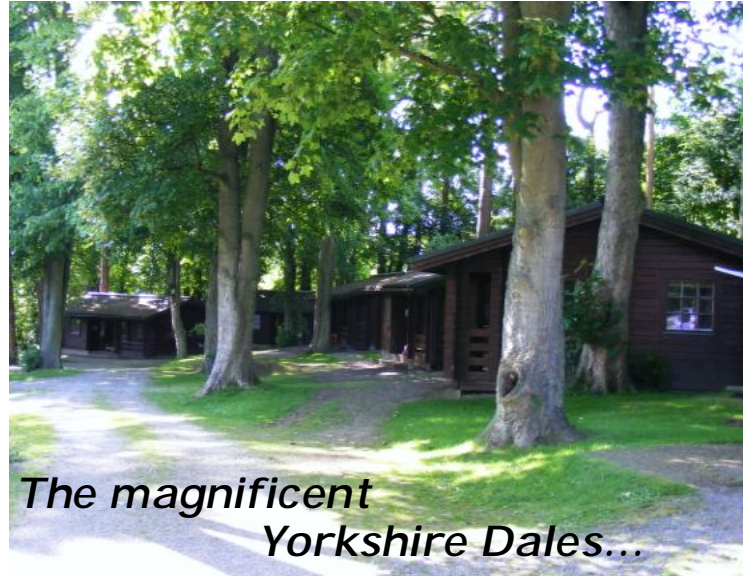

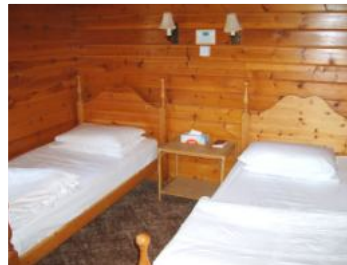
Accommodation



The Centre has twelve Scandinavian styled self-catering log cabins. Nine cabins are located in Elm Wood away from the main complex & the other three are located near to our Granary Barn. Here you will find reception and shop, our main meeting room along with a kitchen (for group use) and two lounges. A laundry room and communal freezer can be found in the centre of Elm Wood and a public telephone box is available for our guests to use near the Granary Barn. Dogs are also welcome at a small surcharge.

All cabins have a colour television; the kitchens are equipped with an electric cooker, microwave, refrigerator, plenty of kitchen equipment, crockery and cutlery; the bathrooms have a bath, basin and WC; heating is provided by storage heaters and small electric heaters are also available for even more comfort.

The front bedroom has two single beds whilst the rear bedroom has a single bed and a bunk-bed. Duvets and pillows are provided but **guests need to bring single** duvet covers, pillow cases and bed sheets. If we are given notice, then bedding can be made available at a small additional charge.

- ◆ The Centre can accommodate up to 84 people. Local B&Bs and a youth hostel can provide additional accommodation if required—details available on request.
- ◆ The ground floor meeting room (measuring 36 feet by 18 feet) is equipped with a keyboard, television, DVD player, OHP, screen, flipchart and lectern and can seat 80 people at 12 tables for meals.
- ◆ The catering kitchen allows groups to plan their own meals. Plenty of fridge, freezer and storage space is available. Alternatively some groups have successfully used local caterers.
- ◆ The Lounge and the Study can be used as additional upstairs meeting rooms. Both are equipped with TV, DVD, VCR, CD/Tape player and can accommodate around 15 people.
- ◆ Wireless internet connection is available for during office hours & requires free registration. It is only available within and near to the Granary Barn.

With such facilities at their disposal, churches, schools and other organisations find the Jonas Centre to be the ideal venue for conferences, training, teaching, fellowship and fun. We welcome enquiries from those who might benefit from what The Jonas Centre can offer and will be pleased to discuss the needs of specific groups.

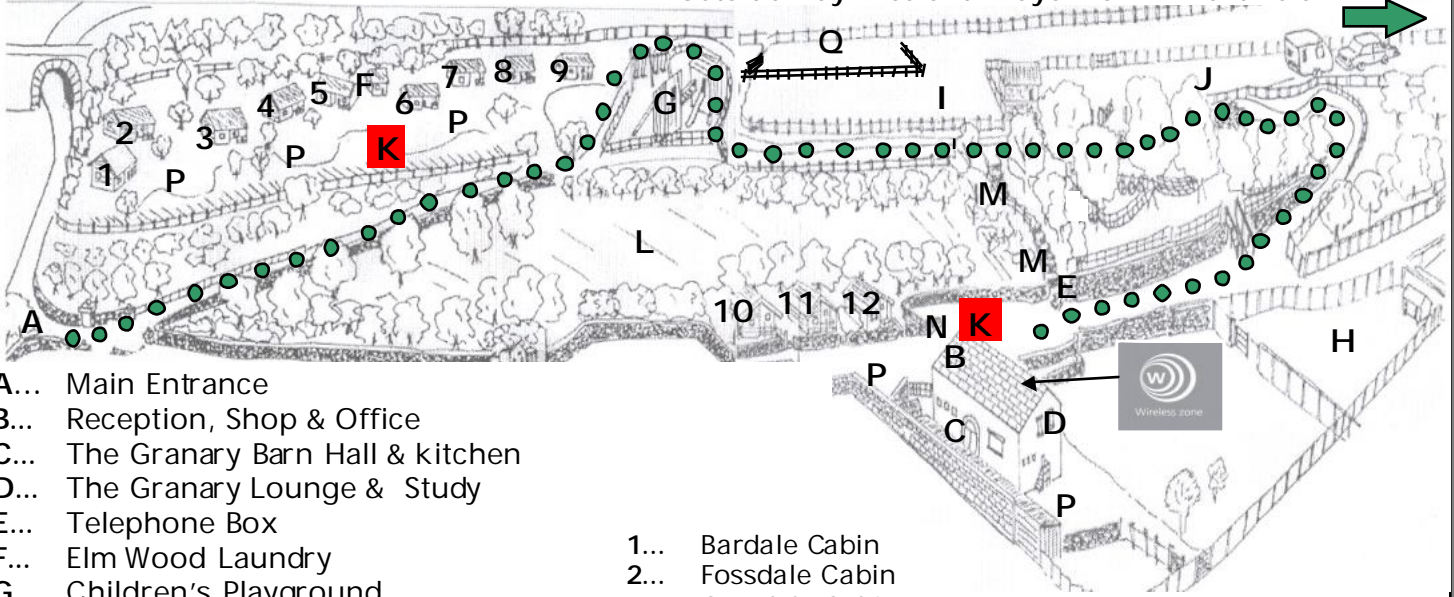
We have chickens, ducks, donkeys, goats and a Shetland pony called Sally — which children and adults love to meet!
